Pharaoh: A Pharaoh was the most important and powerful person in Egypt. The Pharaoh was the political and religious leader of the Egyptian people.

Nomad: A person who is part of a tribe or group that moves from place to place without a permanent home

Potiphar: was the captain of Pharaoh's guards who is said to have purchased Joseph as a slave.

Slave: a person who is the legal property of another and is forced to obey them.
