They enjoy a special meal with prayers and songs. ➤ Holi is the Hindu festival of colour. 		
Year 1 Spring 2	Easter and Surprises <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ On Palm Sunday Christians remember how people welcomed Jesus by waving palm leaves. ➤ On Maundy Thursday Christians remember how Jesus had his last supper with his disciples. ➤ On Good Friday, Christians remember the day that Jesus was crucified. ➤ On Easter Sunday, Christians celebrate Jesus' resurrection.
