It is important to remember that sound quality of learning is more desirable than insecure quantity of learning.

Year 2 Summer 2	<p>Which places are special and why?</p> <div></div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A place of worship is a special place within a religion where believers go to pray, worship, learn about their religion, and spend time as a community.• A Christian place of worship is called a Church. Christians meet on Sundays. It is a place where babies are christened, people are married, and funerals are held.• A Jewish place of worship is called a Synagogue. Jews use synagogues to meet, worship and study. Most people in a synagogue cover their head to show respect• The Hindu place of worship is called a mandir, or Hindu temple.
