### What I Should Already Know:

### Subject Vocabulary:

**Christianity:** A religion based on a belief in God and the life and teachings of Jesus.

**Christian:** People who follow the religion of Christianity.

**Bible:** The Christian holy book

**Judaism:** A religion with one God, who revealed himself through prophets such as Abraham and Moses.

### Unit Specific Vocabulary:

**Leader:** Someone who is in charge of a group or place.

**Teacher:** A person who helps others learn.

**Follower:** A person who does things that other people do first or tells them what to do.

**Abraham:** Abraham is an important figure in several faiths, including Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. People believe that God made a promise to Abraham that his family would become a great nation.

**Moses:** When Moses was an adult, God spoke to him through a burning bush. God told Moses to tell Pharaoh to free the Israelites from enslavement.

**Jesus:** The teacher and the founder of Christianity.

**Miracles:** Events that don't follow the rules of nature and are believed to happen through the power of God.

- Moses was a brave leader. God told Moses to tell the Pharaoh to free the Israelites.
