Children in Need Charity Market Day Friday 14 November 2025

YES! It's back – we will, once again, be joining in with BBC's Children in Need Campaign.

Following the continued success of our previous events, Phases will be celebrating in different ways.

For Key Stage 2 (Years 3 – 6) we will be holding our ever-popular Charity Market. This year Years 3 and 4 will again run theirs in the Lower School Hall and Years 5 and 6 will run theirs in the Upper School Hall.

- ❖ The Charity Market will take place during the morning of Friday 14 November for children from **Years 3 – 6** who wish to hold stalls.
- ❖ Children may work alone or in groups from within their **own year group**.
- ❖ Items sold can be cakes, snacks, drinks, used toys and books or competitions such as Guess the Name of the teddy or the number of sweets in the jar.
(Please note that fizzy drinks, glass bottles or items containing nuts should not be brought in to sell).
- ❖ Items should be priced simply – we suggest anything from 10p to 50p.
- ❖ Children will require a "float" of change. This should be separate to the money they may wish to bring to spend on other stalls.
- ❖ Children will be responsible for items such as table coverings, tins and boxes that they use. It would be helpful for these to be labelled with your child's name and class in case we need to re-unite them! If you want your child to bring home any tins/containers etc... **it is essential these are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.**
- ❖ All proceeds will be collected centrally by the School and donated to Children in Need.
- ❖ **Children will need to be able to bring their own items into school, as parents will not be able to come in with them. Please consider the number of items your child brings in for sale, so it is manageable for your child. We would rather all items be sold during the morning to avoid being left with huge numbers of unsold items.**
- ❖ **Any items which are left will be used for an end of day sale, which will take place either in the Upper School Hall or Front Playground. An email will be sent to confirm this on the day.**

- ❖ Children are also responsible for ensuring that they tidy away at the end of the Charity Market. Please ensure your child understands which items they should bring home if not sold and those which they are allowed to dispose of or donate to the end of day sale.

Children in Years 3 – 6 who do not wish to run a stall will be able to visit the Charity Market for their Phase, to browse and make purchases. It would be helpful to send them in with an additional carrier bag for items they do purchase and a named purse or wallet containing different denominations of coins.

Children from Years 3 to 6 who wish to run a stall must submit one Form per group which is signed by an adult. **All applications must be returned to your child's class teacher by 9am on Tuesday 11 November.** Late applications after this date cannot be considered. Children have had the opportunity to collect a Form from their class teacher today.

Children in **Year 2** will be able to attend the Year 3/4 Market in the Lower School Hall. They will need to bring a carrier bag for their purchases and a named wallet or purse with different denominations of coins.

Children in **Nursery, Reception and Year 1** will complete a variety of Children in Need themed activities throughout the day and celebrate with cakes which are purchased for them and delivered by our Charity Team and other Year 6 helpers.

As this is a fundraising day, all children (Reception – Year 6) may come to school in their own clothing, including any Children in Need merchandise they have, such as Pudsey ears. Please note that our usual rules on hair, make-up, jewellery and appropriate clothing and shoes still apply.

We are really looking forward to another fantastic morning when we can once again witness how creative and entrepreneurial our children are. We look forward to sharing more about the day on our Facebook page and School Website.
