clothing & wellingtons or appropriate outdoor footwear are essential for all children to take part in the day's activities. The children will not need any spending money with them on the day.

#### Essential Items:

- ❖ Warm, multi-layered clothing (i.e. t-shirt or under layer, fleece and a jacket) as it's always better to have a few layers than rely on a single thick jumper.
- ❖ A water-proof.
- ❖ If the children have anything else which is waterproof, e.g. trousers, then this is ideal.
- Gloves to keep your child's hands warm whilst outside preferably waterproof gloves.
- Wellington boots or walking boots for being outdoors in the mud and wet field.
- ❖ Please ensure your child brings a change of footwear and change of socks with them for after the activities to change into before getting back on the coach.
- ❖ A spare carrier bag to place the walking or wellington boots into will also be needed.

We will be leaving school between 8:45am and 9am – it is, therefore, essential that your child is on time to school for the final safety briefing and we will return in time for the normal end of day collection.

The children will need a packed lunch and their water bottle (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or items that contain nuts).
