<p><b>EYFS Development Matters Statements</b></p> <p><b><u>Communication and Language</u></b></p>	<p><b><u>The Nursery Year</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.</li> <li>• Use a wider range of vocabulary.</li> <li>• Understand a question or instruction that has two parts.</li> <li>• Understand 'why' questions, like: "Why do you think the caterpillar got so fat?"</li> <li>• Sing a large repertoire of songs.</li> <li>• Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books, and be able to tell a long story.</li> <li>• Develop their communication, but may continue to have problems with irregular tenses and plurals</li> <li>• Use longer sentences of four to six words.</li> <li>• Be able to express a point of view and to debate when they disagree with an adult or a friend, using words as well as actions.</li> <li>• Can start a conversation with an adult or a friend and continue it for many turns.</li> <li>• Use talk to organise themselves and their play:</li> </ul>
<p><b>EYFS Development Matters Statements</b></p> <p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p>	<p>Understand the five key concepts about print:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- print has meaning</li> <li>- print can have different purposes</li> <li>- we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom</li> </ul> <p>Develop their phonological awareness, so that they can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- spot and suggest rhymes</li> <li>- count or clap syllables in a word</li> <li>- recognise words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother</li> </ul> <p>Engage in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary.</p> <p>Use some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; write 'm' for mummy.</p> <p>Write some or all of their name.</p> <p>Write some letters accurately.</p>
